



Dear Relief Team Member,

With gratitude and joy, we welcome you to our campus! We know this isn't a five-star hotel, but our hope is that you will find everything you need while you are here. If you have a need that arises during your stay, please have your team leader contact Deb Ralph the Site Co-ordinator. We will work as quickly as possible to resolve that need so you can continue to do the important work with which you are engaged. If during your stay, you find that you need help locating food, shopping, medical treatment, and other services, we have compiled this brief booklet to let you know of some places nearby that we recommend and also our Host teams will be happy to assist you.

Here are a few items you might want to know while you are here with us:

- The internet network and password are posted in the sleeping spaces, but in case that sign has moved, been blocked, or fallen:
 - Network: ReliefTeam
 - Password: Relief2024!
- It is important that the Team Leader sign in on arrival and departure using the Log In sheet provided in the main entrance area downstairs.
- The address for the church is 13400 Park Blvd. Seminole, FL 33776 should you need anything delivered.
- Your accommodations are in our building named "The Foundry."
- Your vehicles should be safe in the rear parking lot at night farthest from the road, but we do encourage locking them as this is still accessible to the neighborhood and those passing by the property.
- Please make sure you leave exterior doors locked at all times for your and our campus' safety and always leave the key in the lockbox.
- One shower is located in the handicap stall of both the men's and women's restroom on the main floor of the Foundry and there is a shower block for men on the west side which should be locked when not in use.

- Help yourself to the Foundry kitchen for preparing simple microwave meals and to prepare sandwiches etc. There is no cooking allowed. There is one side of the large refrigerator available for your use and one large freezer. Please leave it clear and tidy on Wednesdays in preparation for our cooking team and Wednesday night program.
- Please help yourself to water and take a case or two with you to your worksite every day, and put a fresh case or two in the refrigerator each time so that you can continue to have cool water.
- There are coolers available for your use if required and there is an ice-maker downstairs.
- We have provided a small kitchenette in Room 28 that has a toaster, 2 microwaves, 2 coffee makers and a few snacks/breakfast cereals. There is also a large refrigerator/freezer and small refrigerator. Please help yourself and if there is anything you need, please let your Host team know.
- If anything is dirty or breaks, please inform Deb Ralph immediately and we will get it taken care of for you during your stay.
- AA groups meet almost every evening on our campus. Don't be alarmed when you see and hear people walking around in the evening. Some may even try to enter the Foundry if this is their first time.
- Girl Scout Troops and other meetings also happen almost every day.
- The Preschool on our property operates from about 6:30am to about 7pm every evening with students and teachers coming and going through the back parking lot and breezeway between the Foundry and the school.
- Our church praise band practices Thursday evenings starting at around 6:30pm as needed. Don't be alarmed when you start to hear drumming, singing, and guitars during that time.
- We have a Wednesday night community dinner combined with entertainment and a selection of classes which you are invited to attend.
- Church Office Hours are from 8:30am to 4:30pm Monday through Friday. Phone 727-391-4769.
- Our worship times are 8:30am Contemporary Service in the Foundry and 10am Traditional Service in the Sanctuary every Sunday.
